A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. (a) The judiciary shall establish a temporary
 task force to examine the use of electronic filing for requests
 for and issuance of domestic abuse temporary restraining orders
 on nights and weekends.
- (b) In establishing the task force, the judiciary shallexamine the electronic temporary restraining order program in
- 7 New Jersey, known as "E-TRO."
- 8 The task force shall also consider allowing the use of
- ${f 9}$ electronic signatures of judges and complainants on nights and
- 10 weekends, as well as the immediate appearance of complaints on
- 11 the judiciary's website for service and enforcement.
- 12 (c) The police departments and prosecuting attorneys in
- 13 each county shall cooperate with the judiciary to develop and
- 14 implement the task force.
- 15 (d) The task force shall consist of eight members as
- 16 follows:
- 17 (1) One member of the house of representatives appointed
- by the speaker of the house of representatives;

 - (6) Three members appointed by the governor, to be selected from a list comprising three names chosen by the speaker of the house of representatives and three names chosen by the president of the senate, with each member representing a different organization that represents domestic violence victims.
 - (e) The members of the task force shall serve without compensation and shall receive no reimbursement for expenses.
- 18 (f) The judiciary shall submit a report of the task
 19 force's findings to the legislature no later than twenty days
 20 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2010. The
 21 report shall include information and recommendations about the
 22 efficacy of and costs associated with the electronic temporary

- 4 (g) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 2010.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
