15	(c)	That	person enters or remains unlawfully in or upon

18		reaso	onable warning or request to leave by school

4	(d) That	person enters or remains unlawfully in or upon

7	or re	quest to leave by housing authorities or a police	
8	offic	er; provided that:	
9	<u>(i)</u>	A warning or request to leave shall not be	
10		necessary between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.; and	
11	<u>(ii)</u>	The person is not an invited guest. For purposes	
12		of this section, an "invited guest" means a	
13		person who enters or remains in or upon the	
14		premises of any public housing project in	
15		response to an express or implied invitation of a	
16		resident and who is not in violation of any law

18	SECTION 2.	This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
19	matured, penalt	ies that were incurred, and proceedings that were
