### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Hawaii generates well over 15,000 tons of waste 2 each year. According to Waste Management Hawaii, recycling one 3 ton of glass saves forty-two kilowatt-hours of energy, five 4 gallons of oil, and two cubic yards of landfill space; recycling 5 one ton of aluminum saves fourteen thousand kilowatt-hours of 6 energy, over sixteen hundred gallons of oil, and ten cubic yards 7 of landfill space; and recycling one ton of plastic saves over fifty-seven hundred kilowatt-hours of energy, six hundred 9 eighty-five gallons of oil, and thirty cubic yards of landfill 10 Plastic is reusable for a wide range of uses, from 11 plastic foam insulations in homes and buildings to protective vests for police officers. Recognizing this, the legislature 12 13 established the Hawaii HI-5 recycling program in January of 2005 14 for plastic, glass, and aluminum beverage containers. 15 Every public school in Hawaii has vending machines for
