A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

 statewide silver alert program to be activated on behalf of a

alert program shall be integrated with the preexisting Maile
Amber Alert program and partnership.
