BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 11-205.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the person who enters into 3 "(a) any contract with the State, any of its counties, or any 4 department or agency thereof either for the rendition of 5 personal services, the buying of property, or furnishing any 6 7 material, supplies, or equipment to the State, any of its 8 counties, department or agency thereof, or for selling any land 9 or building to the State, any of its counties, or any department 10 or agency thereof, if payment for the performance of the 11 contract or payment for material, supplies, equipment, land, 12 property, or building is to be made in whole or in part from 13 funds appropriated by the legislative body, at any time between 14 the [execution of the contract] submission of a bid for a 15 contract under chapter 103 or 103D or the submission of an application for a grant or subsidy under chapter 42F through the 16 17 completion of the contract, to:
