RELATING TO ATTORNEYS' FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 607-14.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "§607-14.5 Attorneys' fees and costs in civil actions.

4 (a) In any civil action in this State where a party seeks money damages or injunctive relief, or both, against another party, 5 6 and the case is subsequently decided, the court may, as it deems 7 just, assess against either party, whether or not the party was 8 a prevailing party, and enter as part of its order, for which 9 execution may issue, a reasonable sum for attorneys' fees and 10 costs, in an amount to be determined by the court upon a 11 specific finding that all or a portion of the party's claim or defense was frivolous as provided in subsection (b). 12

In any civil action in this State where a medical tort, as defined by chapter 671 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, is claimed, the court shall issue as part of its order that the prevailing party be paid a reasonable sum for attorneys' fees and costs, in an amount to be determined by the court upon a





1	specific finding that all or a portion of the party's claim or
2	defense was frivolous as provided in subsection (b)."
3	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5	begun, before its effective date.
6	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
