RELATING TO UNADJUDICATED TRAFFIC FINES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and			
3	to read as follows:			
4	"PART . TRANSMITTAL OF TRAFFIC FINES			
5	AND FORFEITURES TO COUNTIES			
6	§291C-A Definitions. As used in this part, unless the			
7	context clearly requires otherwise:			
8	"Traffic infraction" means the same as defined under			
9	section 291D-2.			
10	"Uncontested traffic infraction" means a traffic infraction			
11	for which the person notified in section 291D-5 does not contest			
12	the infraction. A person does not contest the infraction if, in			
13	accordance with section 291D-6(b)(1), the person admits the			
14	commission of the infraction without requesting a hearing to			
15	explain mitigating circumstances and pays or remits bail			
16	forfeiture by mail, via the Internet, or by telephone within			
17	thirty days.

outstanding traffic citations and judgments. The penalties 1 2 shall be established pursuant to rules approved by the supreme 3 court; provided that the amounts of the penalties shall be based 4 upon a graduated scale that increases in proportion to the 5 length of the delinquency. Any interest penalty imposed as 6 provided in this section may be waived by the court for good 7 cause. All penalties collected for such outstanding citations 8 and judgments shall be paid to the director of finance of the 9 State. The judiciary shall identify those fines paid for 10 uncontested traffic infractions as defined in section 291C-A." 11 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section 12 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 13 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 14 the new sections in this Act.

15 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION
17 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
