A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR BIG ISLAND JUVENILE INTAKE AND ASSESSMENT CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide start-up
- 2 funding for a pilot site for a juvenile intake and assessment
- 3 center in Pahoa, Hawaii, that will serve about forty youth per
- 4 month over the next two years, with future sites proposed for
- 5 Naalehu, Waimea, Kailua, and Hilo on the island of Hawaii. The
- 6 center will provide a single point of entry for intake,
- 7 assessment, and case management of delinquent and at-risk youth.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,600,000 or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 as a
- 11 grant-in-aid for the county of Hawaii to fund the juvenile
- 12 intake and assessment center pilot site in Pahoa, Hawaii.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 14 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
