A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 587, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 2 3 to read as follows: 4 "PART . CHILD WITNESS TO DOMESTIC ABUSE Definitions. As used in this part: 5 §587-"Domestic abuse" shall have the same meaning as defined in 6 7 section 586-1. 8 "Law enforcement officer" shall have the same meaning as 9 defined in section 701-118(10). 10 Child witness to domestic abuse; reporting. (a) §587-11 A law enforcement officer shall notify the department whenever 12 substantial evidence exists to support a finding by the law 13 enforcement officer that a child has witnessed an incident of 14 domestic abuse inflicted upon the child's parent or legal 15 guardian. 16 (b) In determining whether substantial evidence exists for

- SECTION 2. (a) The department of human services shall

 collaborate with law enforcement, prosecuting attorneys, child

 abuse and domestic violence experts and organizations,

 community-based organizations serving abused children and

 victims of domestic violence, and other relevant agencies and

 organizations to develop protocols and procedures related to the

 provisions established in section 1 of this Act.
- 17 (b) The department of human services shall submit a report
 18 of its findings and recommendations, including any suggested
 19 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
 20 to the convening of the regular session of 2010.
- 21 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 22 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 to allow
- 2 the department of human services or other authorized agencies
- 3 with which the department chooses to contract, to assist victims
- 4 of domestic violence to obtain temporary restraining orders.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.

Description:

Requires law enforcement officers to report to the Department of Human Services (DHS) when a child witnesses an incident of domestic abuse and to collaborate on the development of protocols for the process. Appropriates funds to assist domestic violence victims with temporary restraining orders. (HB873 HD1)
