- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 657D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately 10
- 11 designated and to read as follows:
- 12 Extension of foreclosure. If at any time a "§657D-
- 13 person in the Hawaii national guard defaults upon any obligation
- 14 to make payments on a loan secured by a mortgage upon real
- 15 property owned by the person, no proceeding may be commenced in
- any court to enforce the obligation arising out of nonpayment 16
- 17 until one year after the person redeploys from active duty."
