#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

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timbers, reinforcing steel, structural steel, or other objects of a structural nature which cannot be readily dismembered; provided that when transported by night every such vehicle shall be equipped with a sufficient number of clearance lamps upon the extreme ends of any projecting load to clearly mark the dimensions of the load."
