A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC GUNS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 134-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§134-16 Restriction on possession, sale, gift, or
4 delivery of electric guns. (a) It shall be unlawful for any
5 person, including a licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, or
6 licensed dealer, to possess, offer for sale, hold for sale,
7 sell, give, lend, or deliver any electric gun.

8 (b) Any electric gun in violation of subsection (a) shall9 be confiscated and disposed of by the chief of police.

(c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement
officers [of county police and sheriff departments] of this
State[7] or vendors providing electric guns to those entities;
provided that electric guns shall at all times remain in the
custody and control of the county police [or sheriff
departments.], the county liquor authorities, or the department
of public safety, as appropriate.
