A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC GUNS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 4 delivery of electric guns. (a) It shall be unlawful for any
- 5 person, including a licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, or
- 6 licensed dealer, to possess, offer for sale, hold for sale,
- 7 sell, give, lend, or deliver any electric gun.
- 8 (b) Any electric gun in violation of subsection (a) shall
- 9 be confiscated and disposed of by the chief of police.
- 10 (c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement
- 11 officers [of county police and sheriff departments] of this
- 12 [State,] state, or vendors providing electric guns to those
- 13 entities; provided that electric guns shall at all times remain
- 14 in the custody and control of [the county police or sheriff
- 15 departments.] law enforcement officers.
- 16 (d) [The county police and sheriff departments of this
- 17 State | Law enforcement officers authorized by this section to
- 18 possess electric guns shall maintain records regarding every



- 1 electric gun in their respective custody and control. [Such]
- 2 The records shall report every instance [of usage of the] $\underline{\text{in}}$
- 3 which an electric [guns; in particular, records] gun is used and
- 4 shall be maintained in a similar manner as for those of
- 5 discharging of firearms. [The county police and sheriff
- 6 departments] Law enforcement officers authorized by this section
- 7 to possess electric guns shall annually report to the
- 8 legislature regarding these records twenty days before the
- 9 beginning of each session.
- 10 (e) For the purposes of this section:
- "County liquor authorities" means the county liquor
- 12 commissions or liquor control adjudication board established
- 13 pursuant to part II of chapter 281.
- 14 <u>"Law enforcement officers" includes a police officer</u>
- 15 employed by a county police department, any investigator
- 16 employed by a county liquor authority under section
- 17 281-17(a)(5), or any sheriff, deputy sheriff, or narcotics
- 18 enforcement officer under the control or jurisdiction of the
- 19 department of public safety, pursuant to section 26-14.6."

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
