HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE PHASE OUT OF PRODUCTION AND IMPORTATION OF DECABROMODIPHENL ETHER (DECABDE) AND ALL OTHER POLYBROMINATED DIPHENYL ETHERS (PBDES) IN THE UNITED STATES.

. WHEREAS, polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) have been 1 used extensively as fire retardants in many common household 2 3 products for the past thirty years; and 4 WHEREAS, studies on animals show that PBDEs can affect 5 behavior and learning after birth and into adulthood, making 6 7 exposure to fetuses and children a particular concern; and 8 WHEREAS, PBDEs have the potential to disrupt thyroid 9 hormone balance and contribute to a variety of developmental 10 11 learning disabilities, and may also have the potential to cause cancer; and 12 13 WHEREAS, substantial efforts to eliminate PBDEs from 14 consumer products have been made throughout the world in both 15 the private and public sectors, and these efforts have produced 16 numerous safe alternatives that meet stringent fire code 17 standards; and 18 19 WHEREAS, on December 17, 2009, as the result of 20 negotiations with the United States Environmental Protection 21 Agency, the two U.S. producers of the PBDE decabromodiphenyl 22 ether (decaBDE), Albemarle Corporation and Chemtura Corporation, 23 and the largest U.S. importer, ICL Industrial Products, Inc., 24 announced commitments to phase out decaBDE in the United States; 25 26 and 27 WHEREAS, decaBDE is a flame retardant which has been used 28 in electronics, wire and cable insulation, textiles, automobiles 29 and airplanes, and other applications; and 30 31





WHEREAS, these companies have committed to end production, 1 importation, and sales of decaBDE for most uses in the United 2 States by December 31, 2012, and to end all uses by the end of 3 4 2013; and 5 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency has also 6 announced its intent to encourage the other minor importers of 7 decaBDE to join this initiative; now, therefore, 8 9 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 11 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that the Legislature supports 12 this phase out of production and importation of decaBDE and all 13 other PBDEs in the United States; and 14 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature encourages the Environmental Protection Agency to continue its efforts to 17 encourage the remaining minor importers of decaBDE to end their 18 importation of decaBDE into the United States; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Administrator of the 22 United States Environmental Protection Agency and to Hawaii's 23 24 congressional delegation. 25 26 27
