HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CLEAN AND SOBER HOME AND HALFWAY HOUSE TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, clean and sober homes and halfway houses provide a 1 means for persons to return to the community through support in 2 a home-like environment without the rigid structure of a 3 therapeutic care facility or therapeutic living program; and 4 5 WHEREAS, many persons being released from incarceration 6 need the support of a home environment while trying to deal with 7 the stressors of reintegrating back into society while 8 maintaining sobriety; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS, community residents have expressed concerns over the legal operation of such homes in their immediate vicinity 12 and their compliance with all state and county laws; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the needs and concerns of the community must be 15 16 tempered with the needs of the individuals requiring support; 17 now, therefore, 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 20 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Health is 21 requested to establish a clean and sober home and halfway house 22 task force to address the following issues: 23 24 Establishing clear occupancy requirements of clean and 25 (1) sober homes and halfway houses (facilities); 26 27 Develop a plan of accountability for these facilities 28 (2) to ensure compliance with occupancy and other 29 requirements; in developing the plan the task force 30 shall review the need for or appropriateness of 31 32 regulation of these facilities, as well as the most appropriate practices regarding regulation; and 33

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force submit to the 10 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 11 the Regular Session of 2011, a report on the findings and 12 recommendations of the task force and any proposed legislation 13 that may be necessary to effectuate those recommendations; and 14

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 16 17 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, Director of Health, the Director of the City and County of Honolulu 18 Department of Planning and Permitting, the Director of the 19 County of Hawaii Department of Planning, the Director of the 20 County of Maui Department of Planning, the Director of the 21 County of Kauai Department of Planning, and the Chair and 22 Administrator of the Hawaii Paroling Authority. 23 24
