15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of 17 Transportation, the Director of the Maui County Department of 18 Transportation, the Mayor of the County of Maui, the Chairperson 19 of the County Council of the County of Maui, and the President 20 of the Car and Truck Rental and Leasing Association.
