HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO REPORT ON THE FUEL EFFICIENCY OF VEHICLES IN EACH EXECUTIVE AGENCY'S FLEET.

WHEREAS, eighty per cent of the energy resources used in 1 Hawaii and almost all of the fuel used by motor vehicles in 2 Hawaii are imported from other countries or the mainland United 3 4 States; and 5 WHEREAS, fuel-efficient vehicles conserve fuel resources 6 7 and make the State less dependent on imported oil and motor vehicle fuels; and 8 9 WHEREAS, fuel-efficient vehicles also emit less pollution 10 and carbon emissions, thus helping to preserve Hawaii's natural 11 environment; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, fuel costs make a up a significant portion of the motor vehicle fleet budgets of state government agencies, and 15 the use of more fuel-efficient vehicles would result in savings 16 17 to those agencies; and 18 WHEREAS, in addition to the budgetary benefits of fuel 19 efficiency, state departments can improve the environment and 20 reduce Hawaii's dependence on imported oil by increasing fuel 21 22 efficiency in their vehicle fleets; and now, therefore, 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 24 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 25 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 26 27 Accounting and General Services is requested to provide a report to the Legislature on the motor vehicle fleets of each executive 28 agency under its administration containing information on: 29 30 (1) Types of vehicles; 31



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1 (2) Fuel efficiency of each type of vehicle; 2 3 (3) Progress made in improving the fuel efficiency of the 4 5 fleet; and 6 7 (4) Each agency's plans to promote further improvement in 8 fuel efficiency; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting 11 and General Services is requested to report its findings to the Legislature not later than twenty days prior to the convening of 12 the Regular Session of 2011; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 15 16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Comptroller. 17 18 Mele Carree Keren Aurne Stjerk Stephime 19 OFFERED BY:
