HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION TO ADOPT THE COURSE OF ACTION RECOMMENDED IN THE 2009 AUDIT REPORT OF THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, a network 1 of thirteen facilities spanning five islands across the State, 2 is one of the largest public hospital systems in the nation; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the 400,000 annual patients served by the Hawaii 5 Health Systems Corporation are an aging, disproportionately 6 7 poor, sick, and underserved population that is expected to grow by seventeen percent by 2017; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation has 10 experienced unprecedented fiscal challenges that has led to an 11 12 immense and unsustainable reliance on annual subsidies that total \$649.2 million since Hawaii Health Systems Corporation was 13 established fifteen years ago; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the State does not have the fiscal capacity to 16 17 continue funding the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation at its current elevated level; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Act 182, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, mandated an 20 annual audit of the management and operations of the Hawaii 21 Health Systems Corporation, its regional system boards, and its 22 facilities: and 23 24 WHEREAS, the audit completed pursuant to Act 182 finds that 25 the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation is in a financially 26 perilous condition and that the age and condition of its 27 28 facilities and other physical assets are well above national averages that prompt serious concerns as to the health and 29 safety of Hawaii's public hospital network; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the audit finds that incremental change is 32 33 insufficient to address the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation's

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short and long term challenges and that immediate, system-wide 1 restructuring of the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation is 2 3 recommended; now, therefore, 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 5 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 6 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Health Systems 7 Corporation is urged to adopt the recommendations of the 8 December 2009 Comprehensive, Independent Review and Evaluation 9 of the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation Final Report as 10 completed by Stroudwater Associates in accordance with Act 182, 11 Session Laws of Hawaii 2009; and 12 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation is directed to draft and submit legislation to the 15 2011 Hawaii State Legislature that is based on the findings of 16 the audit report, which will include but not be limited to the 17 following: 18 19 (1) Converting the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to a 20 private non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation; 21 22 23 (2)Identifying a capital and operating partner; 24 25 (3) Maximizing operational efficiencies within each region and facility; and 26 27 (4) Reconstituting the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation 28 governance and leadership structure; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health. 32 33 Director of Budget and Finance, President of the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, Chairperson of the Hawaii Health Systems 34 Corporation Board of Directors, Chairperson of each regional 35 system board of directors, and the Hawaii Health Systems 36 Corporation Physician Leaders Group. 37 38 Culmenter Son 39 OFFERED BY: 40 41 BY REQUEST 42
