## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, Hawaii's public education system is constantly criticized for the inadequate delivery of educational services and poor student achievement; and
4 5 6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, the large bureaucracy of the Department of Education (DOE) presents roadblocks that could prevent DOE and the individual schools from successfully performing their duties and serving the needs of Hawaii's children; and
10 11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, more recently, DOE became the subject of local and national news when furloughs were imposed in public schools, thereby reducing the number of instructional days for students; and
15 16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, departmental leadership was decentralized through the creation of the complex area system with the intent of placing a greater number of decisions and a larger percentage of moneys directly in the hands of the individual schools and their leaders; and
20 21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the public has raised many questions about DOE's operations, including its finances and management; and WHEREAS, a financial and management audit of DOE is long overdue; and

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1	WHEREAS, Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, aimed to
