## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO RECOGNIZE THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT THAT MAKES THE GREATEST REDUCTION IN ENERGY CONSUMPTION.

WHEREAS, eighty per cent of the energy resources used in 1 Hawaii are imported from other countries or the mainland United 2 3 States; and 4 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii is a significant purchaser and 5 user of energy resources in its many facilities and departments 6 7 throughout the State; and 8 9 WHEREAS, energy costs make up a significant portion of the budgets within the various State executive departments that are 10 administered by the Department of Accounting and General 11 Services; and 12 13 WHEREAS, recent cutbacks in departmental operating budgets 14 have made it necessary for departments to conserve energy in 15 order to reduce costs; and 16 17 WHEREAS, throughout the State, departments have taken a 18 wide variety of actions to reduce energy use and energy costs, 19 20 such as adjusting temperature control systems and de-lamping buildings; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, reductions in energy consumption by state agencies will create cost savings for the State and taxpayers and also 24 reduce Hawaii's reliance on imported energy sources; now 25 26 therefore; 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 29 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the Senate concurring, that state departments are 30

encouraged to continue and increase their efforts to reduce 1 energy consumption; and 2 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting and General Services is requested to track the annual energy 5 6 consumption of the executive departments for which it provides 7 services; and 8 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting and General Services is requested to determine the executive 10 department that demonstrates the greatest reduction in energy 11 use, in percentage terms, between fiscal years 2009-2010 and 12 2010-2011, and publicly recognize that department for its 13 14 accomplishment; and 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting 16 and General Services is requested to report its findings to the 17 18 Legislature not later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and to the Comptroller who, in turn, is requested to distribute copies to 23 the heads of all other executive departments. 24 25 26 27 Jerovallo OFFERED BY:
