HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF VETERANS' SERVICES, ASSISTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, TO DEVELOP A PLAN TO CREATE MEMORIALS TO THE VETERANS OF THE PERSIAN GULF WAR AND WOMEN VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II ON THE GROUNDS OF THE STATE CAPITOL NEAR THE KOREAN AND VIETNAM WAR MEMORIAL.

1 WHEREAS, the freedom and security that citizens of the 2 United States (U.S.) enjoy today are direct results of the 3 sacrifice and continued vigilance maintained by the U.S. Armed Forces over the course of our nation's history; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the sacrifices of members of the U.S. Armed Forces 6 7 have preserved the liberties that have enriched this nation, 8 making it unique in the world community; and 9 10 WHEREAS, members of the United States Armed Forces engaged in the Persian Gulf War from August 2, 1990 to February 28, 11 1991, that culminated in the liberation of Kuwait from the 12 13 invasion by Iraq; and 14 WHEREAS, on July 24, 1994, Hawaii dedicated the Korean and 15 Vietnam War Memorial on the grounds of the State Capitol; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, it is both fitting and necessary for the State to give tangible and visible recognition of the sacrifices and 19 20 contributions of veterans from Hawaii who served in the Persian 21 Gulf War, and women veterans from Hawaii who served in World War 22 II; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 25 of 2010, that the Office of Veterans' Services (OVS), with the 26 assistance of the Department of Accounting and General Services 27 (DAGS) and the Department of Defense (DOD), is requested to 28 29 develop a plan to create memorials to the veterans of the Persian Gulf War and women veterans of World War II on the 30

grounds of the State Capitol near the Korean and Vietnam War 1 2 Memorial; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that OVS is requested to include in the plan information on the availability of funds to support the 5 memorial project from federal, state, and private sources; and 6 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DOD and DAGS are requested to provide assistance to and full cooperation with OVS; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that OVS is requested to submit a 11 report to the Legislature, including any necessary proposed 12 legislation, no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the 13 14 Regular Session of 2011; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Director of the Office of 17

18 Veterans' Services, the Comptroller, and the Adjutant General.
