REQUESTING THAT THE LEGISLATURE CONVENE AN INVESTIGATORY PUBLIC HEARING TO EVALUATE THE BIOSECURITY PROGRAM BY EXAMINING STATE AND COUNTY POLICIES AND PRACTICES THAT AFFECT THE AVAILABILITY OF WATER FOR AGRICULTURE AND MAINTENANCE OF AGRICULTURAL IRRIGATION SYSTEMS.

1 WHEREAS, the unchecked spread of invasive species is one of the greatest threats to Hawaii's economy, natural environment, 2 and the health and lifestyle of Hawaii's people; and 3 4 WHEREAS, invasive pests can cause millions of dollars in 5 6 crop losses, the extinction of native species, the destruction of native plants, the spread of disease, and the quarantine of 7 exported agricultural crops; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, sufficient support for a biosecurity program is vital to the public's health and welfare; and 11 12 WHEREAS, in 2008, the Legislature established a biosecurity 13 program by adding part VI to Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised 14 Statutes; and 15 16 WHEREAS, one of the actions identified to achieve the 17 objectives of the biosecurity program is to promote the 18 production of agricultural commodities in the State to reduce 19 cargo shipments of imported commodities into the State; and 20 21 WHEREAS, sufficient quantities of water and maintenance of 22 irrigation infrastructure are essential to support viable 23 24 agricultural production on a scale necessary to meet the objectives of the biosecurity program; and 25 26 WHEREAS, various state and county agencies have regulatory 27 jurisdictions that impact the availability of water for 28 29 agricultural production and the maintenance of agricultural hrrigation systems; and 30 31

WHEREAS, the Legislature wants to ensure that the policies 1 and practices of these state and county agencies enable and 2 promote the availability of water for agricultural production 3 and the maintenance of agricultural systems; now, therefore, 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 7 8 of 2010, that the House of Representatives and the Senate convene a joint investigatory public hearing for the purpose of: 9 10 Investigating the policies and practices of the (1)11 various state and county agencies' permitting, 12 approvals, and decisions that affect the availability 13 of water for agricultural production and the 14 maintenance of agricultural irrigation systems; and 15 16 (2) Identifying any statutory or other amendments that may 17 be necessary to promote and meet the objectives of the 18 biosecurity program; and 19 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture, Department of Health, Department of Land and Natural Resources, 22 Commission on Water Resource Management, Public Utilities 23 Commission, Agribusiness Development Corporation, each county 24 department of water supply, and each county planning department 25 is requested to participate in the investigatory public hearing; 26 27 and 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker of the House of 29 Representatives and the Senate President appoint members from 30 each respective body to constitute a joint committee for the 31 purpose of conducting the investigatory public hearing; and 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 34 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Speaker of the House 35 of Representatives; Senate President; the mayor of each county; 36 the Chairperson of the Agribusiness Development Corporation, the 37 Board of Agriculture, the Board of Land and Natural Resources, 38
