## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE LEGISLATURE CONVENE AN INVESTIGATORY PUBLIC HEARING TO EVALUATE THE BIOSECURITY PROGRAM BY EXAMINING STATE AND COUNTY POLICIES AND PRACTICES THAT AFFECT THE AVAILABILITY OF WATER FOR AGRICULTURE AND MAINTENANCE OF AGRICULTURAL IRRIGATION SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the unchecked spread of invasive species is one of 1 the greatest threats to Hawaii's economy, natural environment, 2 and the health and lifestyle of Hawaii's people; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, invasive pests can cause millions of dollars in crop losses, the extinction of native species, the destruction 6 of native plants, the spread of disease, and the guarantine of 7 8 exported agricultural crops; and 9 WHEREAS, sufficient support for a biosecurity program is 10 vital to the public's health and welfare; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, in 2008, the Legislature established a biosecurity program by adding part VI to Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised 14 15 Statutes; and 16 17 WHEREAS, one of the actions identified to achieve the objectives of the biosecurity program is to promote the 18 19 production of agricultural commodities in the state to reduce cargo shipments of imported commodities into the state; and 20 21 WHEREAS, sufficient quantities of water and maintenance of 22 irrigation infrastructure are essential to support viable 23 agricultural production on a scale necessary to meet the 24 objectives of the biosecurity program; and 25 26 WHEREAS, various state and county agencies have regulatory 27 jurisdictions that impact the availability of water for 28 29 agricultural production and the maintenance of agricultural irrigation systems; and 30

WHEREAS, the Legislature wants to ensure that the policies 1 2 and practices of these state and county agencies enable and 3 promote the availability of water for agricultural production and the maintenance of agricultural systems; now, therefore, 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 7 8 of 2010, that the House of Representatives and the Senate are 9 requested to convene a joint investigatory public hearing for 10 the purpose of: 11 Investigating the policies and practices of the 12 (1)various state and county agencies' permitting, 13 approvals, and decisions that affect the availability 14 of water for agricultural production and the 15 16 maintenance of agricultural irrigation systems; and 17 (2) Identifying any statutory or other amendments that may 18 19 be necessary to promote and meet the objectives of the biosecurity program; 20 21 and 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture, 23 24 Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, Department of Health, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Commission on Water 25 Resource Management, Public Utilities Commission, Agribusiness 26 27 Development Corporation, each county mayor, each county 28 department of water supply, and each county planning department is requested to participate in the investigatory public hearing; 29 30 and 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker of the House of 32 Representatives and the Senate President appoint members from 33 34 each house of the Legislature to constitute a joint committee 35 for the purpose of conducting the investigatory public hearing; and 36 37 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Speaker of the House 39 40 of Representatives; Senate President; mayor of each county; Chairperson of the Agribusiness Development Corporation, Board 41
