HOUSE RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR HAWAII TO PURSUE THE BID TO HOST THE 2016 INTERNATIONAL UNION FOR CONSERVATION OF NATURE WORLD CONSERVATION CONGRESS.

1 WHEREAS, the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) was founded in 1948 and is the world's oldest and largest 2 global environmental network; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the IUCN is a democratic membership union with 5 6 more than 1,000 government and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and almost 11,000 volunteer scientists in more than 160 7 8 countries; and 9 WHEREAS, the IUCN's work is supported by over 1,000 10 professional staff in 60 offices and hundreds of partners in 11 public, NGO, and private sectors around the world; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, there are 87 state members (i.e. nations) officially represented, and 25 government agencies without state 15 membership; and. 16 17 18 WHEREAS, the official United States (U.S.). state representative is the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of 19 20 Oceans and International Environmental and Scientific Affairs; 21 and 22 WHEREAS, funding for the IUCN comes from governments, 23 bilateral and multilateral agencies, foundations, member 24 25 organizations, and corporations; and 26 WHEREAS, the IUCN holds official observer status at the 27 United Nations General Assembly; and 28

WHEREAS, the IUCN World Conservation Congress (WCC) 1 2 convenes every four years and is hosted by a member state, but 3 has never met in the U.S.; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the WCC is a two-part international event: 6 The World Conservation Forum, a 5-day event open to 7 (1)8 all registrants to discuss major sustainable development issues, propose solutions, and facilitate 9 10 the sharing of information and experiences; and 11 (2) The Members' Assembly, a 5-day deliberative session on 12 policy open to official delegates of member 13 14 organizations; 15 and 16 17 WHEREAS, the entire WCC lasts almost two weeks and attracts 18 19 approximately 8,000 delegates from around the world; and 20 WHEREAS, attendees and active participants include, among 21 others, world leaders in policy and conservation, scientists, 22 leaders in communications and alternative energy, indigenous 23 24 groups, prominent world citizens, and Nobel laureates; and 25 WHEREAS, the theme for the 2016 WCC will be "Oceania"; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the IUCN WCC is an opportunity for 28 29 transformational change globally, within the nation, and for the State of Hawaii; and 30 31 WHEREAS, with increased attention from world governments, 32 NGOs, researchers, and the public to marine and island systems, 33 Hawaii offers an outstanding site for the next WCC; and 34 35 WHEREAS, Hawaii is ideally poised to host the WCC, as its 36 geographic location serves as a bridge from the West to Oceania 37 38 and Asia; and 39 WHEREAS, the WCC would offer Hawaii an opportunity to 40 display its natural and cultural diversity to the world; and 41

WHEREAS, Honolulu is a world-renowned visitor destination 1 2 and has the capability and facilities required to stage the IUCN 3 WCC: and 4 5 WHEREAS, tourism is Hawaii's largest employer, revenue producer, and growth sector, and hosting international 6 conferences is critical to the economic well-being of the State; 7 8 now, therefore, 9

10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 11 12 of 2010, that this body expresses its support for Hawaii to pursue the bid to host the 2016 IUCN WCC; and 13 14

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Assistant Secretary for the 16 Bureau of Oceans and International Environmental and Scientific 17 18 Affairs; each member of Hawaii's Congressional delegation; Governor; Director of Business, Economic Development, and 19 Tourism; President and Chief Executive Officer of the Hawaii 20 21 Tourism Authority; and Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.
