## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ENFORCE PROHIBITIONS TO DETER PARKING IN BICYCLE PATHS.

WHEREAS, bicycle paths are set aside for use by bicycles 1 and pedestrians, and are physically separated from motor 2 3 traffic; and 4 WHEREAS, in areas with little parking, cars are often 5 parked in bicycle paths; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, blocking bicycle paths forces bicyclists to run or 9 ride out onto the street; and 10 WHEREAS, parking in bicycle paths creates serious dangers 11 that illegal parking in other areas does not; and 12 13 WHEREAS, section 291C-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 14 prohibits the parking of any vehicle on a bicycle path, except 15 under certain conditions; now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 18 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 19 20 of 2010, that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to post fines on official signs that provide notice that parking in 21 22 bicycle paths is prohibited, and to take other appropriate steps to deter parking in bicycle lanes; and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Honolulu Police Department is 25 requested to regularly enforce the prohibition against parking 26 27 in bicycle paths; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the 30
