HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO EXPAND THE ADVANCEMENT VIA INDIVIDUAL DETERMINATION (AVID) PROGRAM BY OFFERING MORE AVID ELECTIVE COURSES IN PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, the Advancement Via Individual Determination 1 2 (AVID) program is a college-readiness system designed to increase the number of students who enroll in four-year 3 colleges; and 4 5 WHEREAS, although AVID serves all students, it focuses on 6 the least-served students in the academic middle who have a 7 desire to attend college and demonstrate a willingness to work 8 9 hard; and 10 WHEREAS, the AVID program helps high school students better 11 prepare for college expectations by offering a rigorous program 12 of instruction in academic survival and college entry skills; 13 and 14 15 WHEREAS, AVID students enroll in the program as an elective 16 class and learn organizational and study skills, work on 17 critical thinking, receive academic help from peers and college 18 tutors, and participate in enrichment and motivational 19 activities; and 20 21 WHEREAS, nationally, AVID has been adopted in nearly 4,500 22 23 schools, and is available in sixteen countries or territories; 24 and 25 26 WHEREAS, of the 2009 AVID graduates, a total of ninety-two per cent planned to attend college, with sixty per cent planning 27 to attend four-year colleges and thirty-two per cent planning to 28 attend two-year colleges; and 29 30

WHEREAS, in the 2009-2010 school year, there are fifty-1 eight AVID sites in Hawaii, including nineteen high schools and 2 five combination high schools; and 3 4 WHEREAS, if the AVID program were more widely available in 5 Hawaii public high schools, more students could be prepared for 6 the challenges of college; now, therefore, 7 8 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 9 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 10 of 2010, that the Department of Education is urged to expand the 11 AVID program by offering more AVID elective courses in the 12 public high schools; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 15 Resolution be transmitted to the Superintendent of Education and 16 the Chairperson of the Board of Education. 17 18 19 20 OFFERED BY: wa Manunt un Thou HR LRB 10-1686.doc MAR 1 0 2010
