HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO IMPLEMENT AN EARLY WARNING SYSTEM KNOWN AS THE BLUE ALERT TO EXPEDITE THE APPREHENSION OF VIOLENT CRIMINALS WHO KILL OR SERIOUSLY WOUND COUNTY, STATE, OR FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, brave and dedicated law enforcement officers in 1 the State have been killed or severely injured in the line of 2 duty by violent criminals; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, violent acts committed against law enforcement officers increase the perpetrator's propensity to seriously harm 6 or injure innocent bystanders and other people unauthorized to 7 use deadly force; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the amber and silver alerts, used to notify 10 government agencies and the public in cases of child abductions 11 and missing seniors, respectively, have been successfully 12 implemented in many states; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, in 2008, Texas Governor Rick Perry signed an executive order implementing a "blue alert" program as a means 16 to expedite the apprehension of violent criminals who kill or 17 seriously injure local, state, or federal law enforcement 18 officers; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the blue alert system operates in the same manner 21 as the amber and silver alerts by quickly providing essential 22 information to government agencies and the public when a 23 situation requires the alert to be activated; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the implementation of a blue alert system in the 26 27 State would expedite and assist law enforcement agencies in the apprehension of violent criminals responsible for the death or 28 injury of county, state, or federal law enforcement officers and 29 protect the public from further harm; now, therefore, 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 32 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 33

of 2010, that the Department of Public Safety is requested to implement an early warning system known as the blue alert to expedite the dissemination of information critical to the apprehension of violent criminals who kill or seriously injure county, state, or federal law enforcement officers; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Public Safety 8 is requested to develop a blue alert early warning system with 9 assistance and input from federal and county law enforcement 10 agencies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to Director of Public Safety, the United States Marshal for the district of Hawaii, the Acting Special Agent-in-Charge of the Honolulu office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and to the chief of police in each county.
