HOUSE RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU FOR ITS OUTSTANDING SERVICE IN REDUCING THE BACKLOG OF MUCH NEEDED STREET REPAIRS AND REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONTINUE WITH STREET REPAVEMENT, REPAIRS, AND TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE REPAIR AND REPAVING OF SIDE STREETS ALONG KALIHI STREET.

1 WHEREAS, in recent years, the poor condition of Honolulu's 2 streets has been widely criticized; and 3 4 WHEREAS, streets have fallen into a state of disrepair, 5 thereby presenting a safety risk to children, kupuna, and all 6 pedestrians, and causing anguish to drivers and sometimes damage 7 to vehicles; and 8

9 WHEREAS, while the City and County of Honolulu (C&C) has 10 taken great strides to clear the backlog of much-needed street 11 repairs and repaving, some areas are still in need of remedial 12 attention; and

14 WHEREAS, from Kalihi Uka Elementary School through Kalihi 15 Valley, children walk to and from school on roadways with no 16 sidewalks, or they cross streets without pedestrian lights; and 17

18 WHEREAS, one of these areas is Kalihi, where numerous side 19 streets are in need of repair and repaving; now, therefore, 20

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, that C&C is requested to conduct a feasibility study for the repair and repaving of side streets along Kalihi Street and to address major concerns along Kalihi Street; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the feasibility study focus 28 specifically on:

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(1) Widening, through eminent domain, Kalihi Street, beginning from Kalihi Uka Elementary School to Kalihi Valley Park at the end of Kalihi Valley;



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1 (2) Construction to resolve safety concerns on a blind curve along the 3100 block of Kalihi Street known as 2 3 the "S curve;" 4 5 (3) Construction of sidewalks along the section of Kalihi 6 Street described in item (1); 7 8 (4) Removing telephone poles along the section of Kalihi 9 Street described in item (1) and, instead, placing 10 electrical and telecommunications wires underground; 11 Adding more accessible bus service in Kalihi Valley 12 (5) 13 for certain streets, which may lack access to bus 14 service; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study focuses specifically 17 on Kilohana Street, Wailele Street, Ahihi Street, Murphy Street, Merkle Street, Noe Street, Laulani Street, Pahulu Street, Wahine 18 19 Place, Anuu Place, Manaiki Place, Akone Place, Mahani Loop, 20 Kuikele Street, Papali Place, Violet Street, Numana Road, Puolani Street, Ha'aliki Street, Ukiuki Place, Monte Street, 21 22 Kalaepa'a Drive, Kuapapa Place, Kale Place, Kui Place, Waho Place, Ahuahu Place, Huea Place, Umalua Place, Moani Street, and 23 24 Kapali Street; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that C&C is requested to submit a 27 report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no 28 later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 29 of 2011; and 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 32 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu and neighborhood board 16. 33 34 35 OFFERED BY:
