HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A MANAGEMENT AND FINANCIAL AUDIT OF ALL COMMUNITY-BASED PROGRAMS AND SERVICES RECEIVING MEDICAID FUNDING OR SUBSIDIZING INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAID.

WHEREAS, the nature and extent of the current fiscal crisis 1 has necessitated a re-evaluation of government-provided programs 2 3 and services, including social safety net programs and services; 4 and 5 6 WHEREAS, it is imperative to locate cost-savings within 7 existing social safety net programs and services to preserve them for Hawaii's vulnerable populations; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, one of the largest means of funding social safety net programs and services is the federal Medicaid program; and 11 12 WHEREAS, Medicaid is a partnership program administered by 13 states and funded from federal and state revenues; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Medicaid serves as a source of funding for long-16 term care programs for the elderly and services for adults and 17 children with developmental disabilities and medically fragile 18 19 conditions; and 20 WHEREAS, the Medicaid program will generally not cover 21 long-term care services for a recipient who is not residing in a 22 23 medical institution, but has provided an exception for those 24 recipients in one of the programs that fall under the Department of Human Service's Home and Community Based Waiver Program; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, the Medicaid program also subsidizes eligible individuals in other home and community-based environments 28 29 including Adult Residential Care Homes, Community Care Foster Family Homes, Developmental Disabilities Domiciliary Homes, and 30 Developmental Disabilities Apartment Complexes; and 31 32 WHEREAS, ensuring the proper use and maximization of the 33 federal and state Medicaid funds provided for these home and 34

community-based programs and services is paramount to ensuring 1 their preservation while allowing the state to remain fiscally 2 3 responsible; now, therefore, 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 6 7 of 2010, that the Auditor is requested to perform a management and financial audit of all community-based programs and services 8 receiving Medicaid funding or subsidizing individuals eligible 9 10 for Medicaid for: 11 The biennium period extending from July 1, 2007, to 12 (1) 13 June 30, 2009; and 14 15 (2) The fiscal year extending from July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010; 16 17 and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the management and financial audit include: 20 21 22 (1) Medicaid costs per patient per program for each fiscal 23 year; 24 (2) Discussion of factors impacting any increase or 25 26 decrease in the Medicaid costs per patient per program for each fiscal year; and 27 28 29 (3) Any additional information related to the proper use and maximization of Medicaid funds used for these 30 31 purposes; 32 and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor report all findings 35 and recommendations to the Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2011; and 36
