## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE FORMATION OF A CRISIS TURNAROUND TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that the State of Hawaii is 1 facing an unprecedented economic crisis that has seriously 2 affected our quality of life, 3 threatening the jobs and educations of Hawaii's citizens; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Legislature believes that the people of Hawaii 6 7 elected them to serve and represent their interests in State Government above the interests of their political parties and 8 other affiliations; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the people of Hawaii already have proven capable 11 of running their families and businesses in such a way that 12 allows them to weather the current crisis; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the people of Hawaii have shown themselves to be 15 16 increasingly interested in government affairs and the business of the Legislature through various grassroots campaigns, rallies 17 and testimony; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Legislature believes it 20 is in the best of the State of Hawaii to increase citizen 21 interest participation in government and encourage private sector ideas 22 and initiatives that would help Hawaii overcome the current 23 24 economic crisis; now, therefore, 25 IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 26 BE Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 27 of 2010, that the Governor of the State of Hawaii and the 28 Legislature are requested to convene a Crisis Turnaround Task 29 30 Force (Task Force) to examine all levels of state government spending and make recommendations for increased spending, budget 31

1 deem necessary to help Hawaii through the current economic 2 crisis; and 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Crisis Turnaround Task 4 5 Force consist of four members appointed by the Governor, four members appointed by the President of the Senate, and four 6 7 members appointed by the Speaker of the House with particular emphasis on creating a diverse group of that represents a 8 variety of interests, social groups and industries; and 9 10 IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Crisis Turnaround Task 11 BE Force shall, in an effort to encourage transparency, be given 12 13 access to all documents relating to state finances; and 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all members of the Task Force 15 shall be appointed by August 1, 2010 and meet at least four 16 times during the Interim with every meeting recorded on film; 17 18 and 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Crisis Turnaround Task 20 Force shall submit an interim report to the Legislature no later 21 22 than twenty days before the convening of the Regular Session of 2011, describing their progress and making their 23 24 recommendations; and 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 26 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the President of the 27 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. 28 29 30 31 OFFERED BY:
