HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS TO ADOPT RULES TO PROHIBIT ABUSIVE WORK ENVIRONMENTS.

WHEREAS, healthy and productive employees are the 1 2 cornerstone of successful businesses and a prosperous economy; 3 and 4 5 WHEREAS, unfortunately, many employees are subjected to 6 unhealthy, abusive work environments where workplace bullying, abuse, and harassment are prevalent occurrences, independent of 7 8 membership in a protected group; and 9 WHEREAS, as a result, these employees may experience 10 physical and psychological harm, which negatively impacts job 11 performance and job safety, often manifesting in injuries and 12 13 ⁻ illnesses; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health recognizes general harassment, including workplace 16 bullying, as a form of workplace violence; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, workplace bullying has been defined by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health as the 20 21 repeated intimidation, slandering, social isolation, or humiliation by one or more persons against another; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, the United States Congress has found that employee injuries and illness that arise out of work situations impose a 25 substantial burden on businesses and that these injuries and 26 illnesses can be reduced through the establishment and 27 enforcement of minimum health and safety standards; and 28 29 WHEREAS, accordingly, the Hawaii occupational safety and 30 31 health law ensures safe and healthful working conditions for all 32 employees throughout the State; and 33 WHEREAS, in addition to the current protections under the 34 law, employees need protection from the repeated health-35 HR LRB 10-2035.doc

impairing mistreatment of one person by another to promote safe 1 and healthy work environments; now, therefore, 2 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 5 of 2010, that the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations 6 7 is urged to adopt rules to prohibit abusive work environments; 8 and 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Labor and 10 Industrial Relations is urged to develop and disseminate, at no 11 cost to employers, information on abusive work environments and 12 the legal consequences that employees or employers encounter if 13 they contribute to the creation or perpetuation of abusive work 14 environments; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 17 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Labor and 18 Industrial Relations. 19 20
