HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PLACE A MORATORIUM ON ANY NEW PERMITS FOR OPEN WATER COMMERCIAL MARICULTURE FINFISH OPERATIONS.

1 WHEREAS, mariculture is a specialized branch of aquaculture 2 that involves the cultivation of marine organisms for food and 3 other products in the open ocean, tanks, or enclosed section of 4 the ocean; and

6 WHEREAS, commercial mariculture operations have caused many 7 problems, including failing to respect the rights of native 8 Hawaiian fishing traditions, threatening the marine environment 9 with escaped farmed fish, polluting local waters with heavier 10 concentrations of nitrogen from fish fecal contamination, and 11 interfering with marine wildlife; and

13 WHEREAS, the open water commercial finfish mariculture 14 industry has not justified its existence, demonstrated an 15 appreciable level of economic viability, or contributed to local 16 food security concerns; and

18 WHEREAS, the implementation of modern technologies to 19 alleviate the problems associated with open water commercial 20 finfish mariculture operations have not been successful and has 21 done little to curb the environmental, cultural, and economic 22 problems associated with the industry; and

24 WHEREAS, due to the shortcomings of open water commercial 25 finfish mariculture, the State and the local commercial fishing 26 industry as a whole are focused on safer alternatives, including 27 the development of land-based, closed-loop re-circulating 28 aquaculture systems; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
of 2010, that this body requests that the Board of Land and
Natural Resources place a moratorium on any new permits for
commercial finfish mariculture operations in the State; and
