HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO LEASE AVAILABLE LANDS FOR COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL USES TO NON-HAWAIIANS AT MARKET RATES.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands administers all "available land" in the State designated by the Hawaiian 2 3 Homes Commission Act of 1920, as amended; and 4 5 WHEREAS, commercial and industrial uses on available lands 6 will promote economic activity and growth for the Hawaiian community; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, non-Hawaiian developers and businesses have shown interest in commercial and industrial leases on Hawaiian home 10 11 lands; and 12 13 WHEREAS, to promote economic growth and maintain a fair return on commercial and industrial leases, non-Hawaiian 14 individuals, developers, and businesses should be allowed to 15 lease available lands at market rates; now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 18 19 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 20 of 2010, that this body urges the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands to lease available lands for commercial or industrial uses 21 to non-Hawaiians at market rates; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 24 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Hawaiian 25 Homes Commission. 26 27
