HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO RECOGNIZE THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT THAT MAKES THE GREATEST REDUCTION IN ENERGY CONSUMPTION.

WHEREAS, eighty per cent of the energy resources used in 1 Hawaii are imported from other countries or the mainland United 2 3 States; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii is a significant purchaser and user of energy resources in its many facilities and departments 6 throughout the State; and 7 8 WHEREAS, energy costs make up a significant portion of the 9 budgets within the various State executive departments that are 10 administered by the Department of Accounting and General 11 Services; and 12 13 WHEREAS, recent cutbacks in departmental operating budgets 14 15 have made it necessary for departments to conserve energy in order to reduce costs; and 16 17 WHEREAS, throughout the State, departments have taken a 18 wide variety of actions to reduce energy use and energy costs, 19 such as adjusting temperature control systems and de-lamping 20 buildings; and 21 22 WHEREAS, reductions in energy consumption by state agencies 23 will create cost savings for the State and taxpayers and also 24 reduce Hawaii's reliance on imported energy sources; now 25 therefore; 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 28 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 29 of 2010, that state departments are encouraged to continue and 30 increase their efforts to reduce energy consumption; and 31 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting 33 and General Services is requested to track the annual energy 34

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting and General Services is requested to determine the executive department that demonstrates the greatest reduction in energy use, in percentage terms, between fiscal years 2009-2010 and 2010-2011, and publicly recognize that department for its accomplishment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Accounting and General Services is requested to report its findings to the Legislature not later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and to the Comptroller who, in turn, is requested to distribute copies to the heads of all other executive departments.
