A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 2 education is considering closing certain non-charter public 3 schools due to departmental financial constraints. At the same time, some public charter schools face daunting obstacles such 4 5 as the high cost of rent and less-than-desirable location of 6 their facilities. The purpose of this Act is to require the 7 department of education to incorporate into its school-closing process an opportunity for public charter schools to relocate 8 9 into the facilities formerly occupied by any non-charter public 10 school that is being closed.

SECTION 2. Chapter 302B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

14 "<u>§302B-</u> Occupancy and use of facilities of public
15 <u>schools.</u> (a) When the department begins to consider whether to
16 <u>close any particular public school that is not a charter school,</u>
17 it shall simultaneously give reasonable consideration to making



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1	the facili	ties of the public school, if closed, available for	
2	occupancy	and use by a charter school.	
3	(b)	For purposes of this section:	
4	"Reasonable consideration" includes but is not limited to:		
5	(1)	Promptly notifying all charter schools that the public	
6		school is being considered for closure;	
7	(2)	Affording each charter school an opportunity to submit	
8		a written explanation and justification of why the	
9		charter school should be considered for possible	
10		occupancy and use of the facilities of the public	
11		school if it is closed;	
12	(3)	Fully considering the charter school's submission; and	
13	(4)	Providing a written response to each charter school's	
14		submission after the submission has been fully	
15		considered.	
16	<u>As us</u>	ed in this section, "public school" means any school	
17	that falls	within the definition of public schools in section	
18	<u>302A-101,</u>	except for charter schools."
