A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNADJUDICATED TRAFFIC FINES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: 4 "PART TRANSMITTAL OF TRAFFIC FINES 5 AND FORFEITURES TO COUNTIES 6 §291C-A Definitions. As used in this part, unless the 7 context clearly requires otherwise: 8 "Traffic infraction" means the same as defined under 9 section 291D-2. 10 "Uncontested traffic infraction" means a traffic infraction 11 for which the person notified in section 291D-5 does not contest 12 the infraction. A person does not contest the infraction if, in 13 accordance with section 291D-6(b)(1), the person admits the 14 commission of the infraction without requesting a hearing to 15 explain mitigating circumstances and pays or remits bail 16 forfeiture by mail, via the Internet, or by telephone within

thirty days.

- 4 upon a graduated scale that increases in proportion to the
- 5 length of the delinquency. Any interest penalty imposed as
- 6 provided in this section may be waived by the court for good
- 7 cause. All penalties collected for such outstanding citations
- 8 and judgments shall be paid to the director of finance of the
- 9 State. The judiciary shall identify those fines paid for
- 10 uncontested traffic infractions as defined in section 291C-A."
- 11 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 12 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 13 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 14 the new sections in this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION
- 17 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
