## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
read as follows:

4	" <u>§11-</u> Elections procurement. Notwithstanding any other
5	law to the contrary, if a request for hearing is made pursuant
6	to section 103D-709 with regard to any elections procurement, a
7	final decision shall be issued within thirty days of the receipt
8	of the request for hearing. If a request for judicial review is
9	made pursuant to section 103D-710, a decision shall be issued
10	within thirty days of the filing of the application for judicial
11	review. However, in any event, if a request for hearing or an
12	application for judicial review is not resolved by the fifteenth
13	day of April in an election year, the administrative body or
14	court shall lose jurisdiction, and the award of the procurement
15	by the office of elections shall not be disturbed. All time
16	limitations on actions, as provided for in section 103D-712,
17	shall remain in effect."
