BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Highway; Safety; Reckless Driving; Traffic Violations

Description:

Clarifies penalties for first-time offenders and repeat offenders guilty of one or more traffic violations under the traffic code.
