## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§132D- Illegal fireworks task force; established. (a) 5 There shall be established within the state fire council for 6 administrative purposes an illegal fireworks task force. The 7 task force shall develop a plan and make recommendations to stop 8 the importation of illegal fireworks and explosives into Hawaii 9 and develop a strategy to ensure the safety and security of the 10 airports, harbors, and other facilities and institutions in this 11 State against the discharge of illegal fireworks and explosives. 12 (b) The illegal fireworks task force shall meet a minimum 13 of five times between June 1, 2010, and December 31, 2010. The 14 task force may continue to meet beyond December 31, 2010, if 15 necessary. 16 (c) The state fire council shall provide administrative

17 support to the illegal fireworks task force.
