A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended to read as follows:	
3	"A permit shall be required for the purchase and use of:	
4	(1)	Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
5		upon payment of a fee of [\$25;] \$35;
6	(2)	Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
7		pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon
8		payment of a fee of [\$110;] \$250; and
9	(3)	Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section
10		132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time
11		other than during the periods prescribed in section
12		132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of [\$25.] \$35."
13	SECTION 2. Section 132D-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
14	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:	
15	"(a) The fee for the license required under section 132D-7	
16	shall be $[\$3,000]$ $\$4,000$ for importers, \$2,000 for each	
17	wholesaler's site, \$1,000 for each storage site, and \$500 for

- 1 each retailer's site for each year or fraction of a year in
- 2 which the licensee plans to conduct business and shall be
- 3 payable to the county. The license fees shall be used solely by
- 4 each county fire department to pay for the salary of an auditor
- 5 of fireworks and articles pyrotechnic records and all expenses
- 6 incurred to fulfill the duties required, including the
- 7 inspection of inventory and storage facilities, maintenance of
- 8 required records, and the training of the auditor. The auditor
- 9 shall monitor strict inventory and recordkeeping requirements to
- 10 ensure that sales of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic are made
- 11 only to license or permit holders under this chapter. The
- 12 county shall provide an exemption from the fees under this
- 13 section to nonprofit community groups for importation and
- 14 storage of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic for displays once a
- 15 year."
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
