A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the
4	purchase and use of:
5	(1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
6	upon payment of a fee of [\$25;] \$35;
7	(2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
8	pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon
9	payment of a fee of $[\$110;]$ $\$250;$ and
10	(3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section
11	132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time
12	other than during the periods prescribed in section
13	132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of [\$25.] \$35."
14	SECTION 2. Section 132D-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
16	"(a) The fee for the license required under section 132D-7
17	shall be [\$3,000] \$4,000 for importers, \$2,000 for each

- 1 wholesaler's site, \$1,000 for each storage site, and \$500 for
- 2 each retailer's site for each year or fraction of a year in
- 3 which the licensee plans to conduct business and shall be
- 4 payable to the county. The license fees established by this
- 5 section and section 132D-10 shall be used solely by each county
- 6 fire department to pay for the salary of an auditor of fireworks
- 7 and articles pyrotechnic, records, and all expenses incurred to
- 8 fulfill the duties required, including the inspection of
- 9 inventory and storage facilities, maintenance of required
- 10 records, and the training of the auditor. The auditor shall
- 11 monitor strict inventory and recordkeeping requirements to
- 12 ensure that sales of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic are made
- 13 only to license or permit holders under this chapter. The
- 14 county shall provide an exemption from the fees under this
- 15 section to nonprofit community groups for importation and
- 16 storage of fireworks or articles pyrotechnic for displays once a
- 17 year."
- 18 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Fireworks; Permit Fees; Increase

Description:

Increases the permit fees associated with using and importing fireworks. Requires permit fees for purchasing and using fireworks be provided to the county fire departments. (SB1060 HD1)
