A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. In 2005, the legislature enacted Act 183, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, implementing article XI, section 3, 2 3 of the state constitution regarding important agricultural 4 lands. Act 183 establishes policies and procedures for the identification of important agricultural lands and provides for 5 a process to develop protection and incentive measures for 6 important agricultural lands and agricultural viability. 7 Between 1969 and 2006, the amount of land zoned for agriculture 8 9 declined by over twenty-five thousand acres statewide, according to the Hawai'i Data Book. On O'ahu alone, land under cultivation 10 11 went from one hundred twenty-five thousand acres in 1982 to seventy thousand acres in 2005, according to the Statistics of 12 13 Hawai'i Agriculture compiled by the state department of agriculture. On O'ahu, there is particular concern regarding 14 housing projects that threaten vital agricultural lands in 15 Mokule'ia and Kahuku. 16

	agricultural lands shall be limited to any building or
	development project for which general planning has not
	commenced;
(2)	The building or development project is intended to
	affect parcels of agricultural land with an overall
	(master) productivity rating of class A or B, and
	designated as an agricultural district;
(3)	The building or development project is intended to
	affect parcels of agricultural land located in the
	State of Hawaii, and designated as an agricultural
	district; and

2	permissible use within an agricultural district under

4	(b) The moratorium shall be lifted on June 30, 2109.

7	the appropriate state or county agency for processing and
8	visible construction has already commenced.
