RELATING TO PET ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 586-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4 "(a) Upon petition to a family court judge, an ex parte 5 temporary restraining order may be granted without notice to restrain either or both parties from contacting, threatening, or 6 7 physically abusing each other, and to grant exclusive care of a 8 pet animal, as defined in section 711-1100, to a party, 9 notwithstanding that a complaint for annulment, divorce, or 10 separation has not been filed. The order may be granted to any person who, at the time the order is granted, is a family or 11 12 household member as defined in section 586-1 or who filed a petition on behalf of a family or household member. The order 13 14 shall enjoin the respondent or person to be restrained from performing any combination of the following acts: 15 16 (1) Contacting, threatening, or physically abusing the 17 protected party;

Where necessary, the order may require either or 2 both of the parties involved to leave the premises during the 3 period of the order, and also may restrain the party or parties to whom it is directed from contacting, threatening, or 4 5 physically abusing the applicant's family or household members. 6 The order shall not only be binding upon the parties to the 7 action, but also upon their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, or any other persons in active concert or 8 9 participation with them. The order shall enjoin the respondent 10 or person to be restrained from performing any combination of 11 the following acts: Contacting, threatening, or physically abusing the 12 (1)13 protected party; Contacting, threatening, or physically abusing any 14 (2)person residing at the protected party's residence; 15 16 [or] 17 Entering or visiting the protected party's (3) 18 residence [-]; or Visiting, taking, concealing, threatening, physically 19 (4) 20 abusing, or otherwise disposing of a pet animal, as defined in section 711-1100, that is in the exclusive 21 22 care of the protected party." 2009-0771 SB SMA.doc
