3	"§84-11 Gifts. No legislator or employee shall solicit,
4	accept, or receive, directly or indirectly, any gift, whether in
5	the form of money, service, loan, travel, entertainment,
6	hospitality, thing, or promise, or in any other form, <u>from any</u>
7	lobbyist under chapter 97 or any other person, under
8	circumstances in which it can reasonably be inferred that the
9	gift is intended to influence the legislator or employee in the
10	performance of the legislator's or employee's official duties or
11	is intended as a reward for any official action on the
12	legislator's or employee's part."
13	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
