A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR ELECTRICITY PAYMENTS FOR JUDICIARY FACILITIES STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i. 4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency 5 appropriation to address a projected \$1,104,497 deficit in electricity payments for judiciary managed facilities statewide. 6
- 7 Since local utility companies are dependent upon oil as the
- 8 primary source of fuel, the high world oil prices have directly
- contributed to this shortfall. Although kilowatt per hour 9
- 10 consumption has remained flat or decreased, increased worldwide
- 11 demand, the threat of terrorism, geopolitical concerns, oil
- **12** processing glitches, and natural disasters all have contributed
- 13 to keeping oil prices high, and could lead to further increases
- in oil prices in the near future. Based on a combination of 14
- 15 actual bills paid and projected costs, the shortfall for fiscal
- **16** year 2008-2009 is \$1,104,497 for O'ahu and the neighbor islands.

- 1 Without an emergency appropriation, the judiciary will have to
- 2 defer payment on its May and June 2009 bills.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawai'i the sum of \$1,104,497 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 6 purpose of paying electricity bills incurred in fiscal year
- 7 2008-2009 by the judiciary. The sum appropriated shall be
- 8 expended by the judiciary.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
