A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The widespread impact of the 2008 global 2 financial crisis has forced the State to confront a projected budget shortfall of unprecedented proportion. Based on current 3 4 estimates, and if the State takes no action to reduce 5 expenditures, this deficit is projected to increase to 6 \$1,760,000,000 by fiscal year 2010-2011. In order to reduce the 7 deficit, state agencies have already made deep cuts in their 8 discretionary budgets and are evaluating all options to further 9 reduce their expenditures.

10 Employee furloughs could be one means of addressing the 11 budget deficit with the least amount of disruption to public 12 services. In addition, employee furloughs are a workable and 13 immediate alternative to employee layoffs. However, as 14 employees will sustain reductions in salary caused by the 15 furloughs, it is important to ensure that the rights, 16 privileges, and benefits accruing to such employees are not 17 altered or otherwise affected by any furlough program.
