RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows:

"§132D-17 [Inconsistent county ordinances, rules.] County 3 4 authority. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, [no 5 county shall counties may enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks or articles pyrotechnic, except as required 6 7 in this chapter, that [is inconsistent with or] are more 8 restrictive than [- the provisions of] provided within this 9 chapter. Any ordinances and rules regulating fireworks or 10 articles pyrotechnic that were enacted or adopted by a county 11 before March 31, 1995, except those provisions [which] that are 12 [not inconsistent] consistent with $[_{T}]$ or more restrictive than 13 those of this chapter, are declared void."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 16

Description:

Allows counties to enact ordinances or adopt rules regulating fireworks that are more restrictive than state law regulating fireworks under chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
