RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§353C- Emergency lighting in public meeting places.
5	(a) There shall be required for every theater, public
6	auditorium, and other similar public meeting place that does not
7	have a natural light source and that has a maximum allowable
8	capacity of or more persons to be equipped with an
9	emergency lighting system that will operate during an electrical
10	power outage.
11	(b) For the purposes of this section, the following terms
12	shall have the following meaning:
13	"Public auditorium" means a facility generally open to the
14	public where an audience may observe a live performance,
15	including but not limited to performances involving theatrical
16	works, music, dance, and speeches.

1 "Theater" means a place where a variety of performing arts 2 can take place to form a single artistic theme, including but 3 not limited to speeches, comical routines, gestures, music, 4 dance, visual arts, and other spectacles." 5 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 7
