RELATING TO LIMITING CIVIL LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§663- Owner to person on property during commission of 5 a crime; limited liability. (a) Any owner of any estate or any 6 other interest in real property, whether possessory or nonpossessory, or owner's agent having authority to be on the 7 8 property, including but not limited to a tenant, household 9 member, employee, contractor, or public entity, shall not be 10 liable to any person for any injury or death that occurs upon 11 that property during the course of or after the commission of any of the felonies set forth in subsection (b) by the injured 12 or deceased person, or when a reasonable person would believe 13 14 that any of the felonies set forth in subsection (b) are

Description:

Limits the civil liability of property owners, tenants, and household members to persons injured or killed on a premises during the commission of class A or B felony or certain violent crimes.
