A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRUG TESTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§346- Drug testing. In order to retain eligibility,
- 5 all recipients of general assistance, food stamps, or temporary
- 6 assistance for needy families administered by the department are
- 7 subject to drug testing if there is reasonable suspicion to
- 8 believe that the recipient, while receiving assistance, has
- 9 consumed a controlled substance. The department may terminate
- 10 benefits for any recipient who refuses to consent to a drug
- 11 test, or to any recipient who fails a drug test by testing
- 12 positive for a controlled substance. The department shall adopt
- 13 rules under chapter 91 as necessary to effectuate this section."
- 14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
